The Gasometer Plaza is the subtropical heart of the wider Gasworks Precinct at Newstead Riverpark. While the surrounding development focuses on commercial, retail and residential uses, the Plaza will provide a vibrant public realm that will act as a central hub of entertainment, recreation and retail activity.

Situated within and around the base of the iconic, and heritage listed Gasometer frame, the plaza aims to integrate and celebrate the distinctive history of the site. In collaboration with ML Design, the materials and finishes have been carefully selected to reflect the industrial heritage of the site, while exciting visual and interpretive elements will be used to help tell its story.

JFPs driving vision for the space was to create 'Renewable experiences' by providing a flexible and adaptable space that can change to suit a variety of activities and can accommodate both daily use and special events. The Plaza will be a comfortable, relaxed retreat with the lush subtropical planting, shady grove of trees and raised multi-purpose lawn providing an important balance between soft and hard landscape within a predominantly urban environment.
