Toowoomba Regional Council comissioned JFP to complete a Masterplan over the existing Glenvale Park located in Toowoomba.

While the park was well used by local residents, Council required a Masterplan that would create an exciting destination park for the wider community.

Many of the existing facilities within the park were upgraded or improved as part of the revitalisation project. The new playground proposed by JFP was designed to incorporate multi-aged playground equipment with varying play experiences. Elements of the playground, including park furniture, have been custom designed by JFP to reflect Toowoomba’s cycling heritage and the surrounding sporting facilities.

New path systems have been designed to encourage active use of the park and to improve accessibility to both new and existing facilities. These pathways meander through existing and proposed vegetation, providing passive recreation opportunities.

As part of the masterplan, JFP has to design for the future uses of the park, including an anticipated higher number of users. This required an extension and upgrade of existing carpark facilities, as well as providing improved ammenities such as BBQs and shelters, to support these larger user groups.
