Kirkwood Rd is an arterial ring road which bypasses Gladstone City. The project was initiated by the Gladstone City Council and has received both State and Commonwealth funding. The overall roadway is 10kms in length with Stage 3 being the final 2.4kms needed to complete the bypass. Council's satisfaction with JFP's prior involvement with Stages 1 & 2 of the project, in providing detailed land acquisition and As Constructed Surveys, was instrumental in JFP being appointed to complete the survey for Stage 3.

JFP was familiar with the route of Kirkwood Road due to its long term involvement with the Parksville Estate which surrounds a portion of the road. The terrain along the route is typical of the steep terrain of Gladstone City, which JFP is very familiar with.

JFP was able to successfully capture the data required by Council in the format and to the standards required to facilitate the roadworks. Involvement with the Kirkwood Road Project is proof that JFP is able to successfully assist Local Councils to deliver important major road infrastructure projects.
